

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 05

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT JOY,
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHAPTER 98, TAXATION, REPEALING
ARTICLE II, ADMISSIONS TAX**

WHEREAS, on July 11, 1994 the Township adopted the Mount Joy Admissions Tax Ordinance of 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to repeal Chapter 98 Taxation, Article II Admissions Tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Joy Township:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to repeal the Mount Joy Admissions Tax Ordinance of 1994, now codified in the Mount Joy Township Code of Ordinances as Chapter 98, Article II.

Section 2. Enabling Authority

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the enabling authority of the Local Tax Enabling Act, Act of December 31, 1965, P.L.1257, *as amended*, and the Second Class Township Code.

Section 3. Repeal of Admissions Tax

The Mount Joy Township Admissions Tax Ordinance of 1994, codified as Chapter 98, Article II of the Code of Mount Joy Township, is repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective within five calendar days after the date of enactment of this Ordinance.
