May 3, 1975 Resolution No. 2 Pavement markings

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON LOCAL ROADS WITHIN MT. JOY TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, under Section 205 of the Federal Highway Safety Act of 1973, Federal moneys were allocated for applying Pavement Markings on certain local roads; and

WHEREAS, bituminous or concrete roads sixteen (16) feet or wider, having two hundred fifty (250) vehicles per day or more presently on them, which have not been painted or do not meet present Pavement Marking requirements, are eligible to be marked with one hundred percent (100%) Federal Funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Supervisors of the Township of Mt. Joy of Adams County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, That:

Section 1. The Township does hereby express a desire to participate in the Pavement Marking Demonstration Program of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and wishes to properly mark its local roads in accordance with Department Standard.

Section 2. Authorizes the appropriate (3) Official(s) to complete the required forms as may be necessary to participate in this program.
