2. MJT Zoning	Possible revisions to the current Zoning Map were discussed. The Planning Commission agreed that there is no need for immediate revision to the current Zoning Map. The PA Municipalities Planning Code requires that the township Comprehensive Plan be reviewed every 10 yrs. The current MJT Comprehensive Plan was adopted in 2003. The Planning Commission will begin the process to review in preparation for planning for the next 10 yr period. Future changes in the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances are usually made based on results of this review.		
A. Sewage	Ms. Weiland spoke with the management at White Run Municipal Authority concerning future development and the capacity at their facility. It is the responsibility of the developer to get sewage		

	from a development to the sewage plant. It is also the developer's responsibility to help pay for any			
	enlargement at the plant necessary to accommodate new service from that development.			
B. Water	There is no public water in MJT. A new development or new homes will need to have a well to supply water.			
C. State Grants	Ms. Weiland explained that the PA Municipalities Planning Code states that grants are available for funding of municipality planning, to help with the cost of hiring a consultant for the township Comprehensive Plan. However, a requirement of receiving monies from the state is that the Municipality Comprehensive Plan must also be consistent with the Comprehensive Plan for the county.
