• Zoning Ordinance – Off-Street Parking and Loading Article: Ms. Smith said parking is one of the "generally applicable" standards to any use that has to be satisfied whether it is a permitted use, conditional use or special exception. Ms. Smith went through the document and said if any of them had comments or knew of any other uses that should be listed in the table to contact her. Ms. Jennings moved, seconded by Mr. Hawkins, to recommend the Board of Supervisors accept

the Off-Street Parking and Loading Article with the proposed changes in Sections 3B and C2. Motion carried unanimously.
