	B. Service/Maintenance Contract for Heating/AC System	Mr. Gearhart retracted the contract. Mr. Gearhart indicated that he surveyed several heating/ac companies who indicated that they give free estimates. If filters are the issue we will take care of it in-house. Mr. Gearhart indicated a schedule will be created for regular filter replacement which will be done in- house.	Mr. Gearhart retracted the contract.	

C. Bob Conover - Resignation from ZHB D. Appointment to fill vacancy on ZHB	Mr. Gormont stated that Mr. Conover hand delivered a resignation letter from the ZHB as of January 8, 2013. Mr. Gormont read the letter and thanked Mr. Conover for his service on the Zoning Hearing Board. Mr. Gearhart questioned whether the police officer that Mr. Clark knew would be interested in serving on the ZHB. Mr. Clark stated that he had no idea. Mr. Trostle made a motion to appoint Scott Shriver to the ZHB. Mr. Trostle indicated Mr. Shriver is a long term resident and that he knew him personally.	Mr. Trostle moved, seconded by Mr. Updyke, to approve the appointment of Scott Shriver to the Zoning Hearing Board. Motion carried unanimous.
E. ATV Noise/Dust/Glare/ Emissions/ Accelerated Erosion Complaint – Mr. McCauslin	Mr. Gormont read correspondence received from Mr. McCauslin complaining about ATV use. Mr. Gormont stated that the Township Solicitor has been in contact with Mr. McCauslin's attorney. The Solicitor indicated that attached to this correspondence was correspondence going back for the past year with the exception that none of her correspondence was attached. Included in the correspondence was a letter from the neighbor's attorney telling him that he has not claim. The Solicitor indicated that Cindy Smith, Zoning Officer, has corresponded with Mr. McCauslin informing him that the use is a recreation use which is a use. He also complained about noise, Ms. Smith indicated that while we have a noise ordinance we have no enforcement body to respond to a noise complaint. Mr. McCauslin contacted the County Conservation District asserting that these activities were in wetlands and/or causing soil erosion. The Conservation District did go to the property and did a site visit and County Conservation found that there were no DEP	Ms. Smith will draft a letter to Mr. McCauslin indicating that we have received his correspondence, that the township is not enacting anything at this time. Reiterate the recommendations made in the past and that we hope they can come to an amicable decision.
