The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, February 10, 1982 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved as presented by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2^{nd} by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report and bills to be paid were approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

The Burns plans were approved by motion of Neth, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

Deputy Constable Dave Kemper made an appeal to supervisors that he would donate his use as constable. He also made an appeal to supervisors that he would donate his time and serve as police officer of Mt. Joy Township, motion to table this matter was made by Snyder, 2^{nd} by Hilbert, carried.

Road takeover - Charlie Scott to come over next month to discuss this again. Florence Helman - heard nothing about this situation.

Calvin Keefer - send certified letter to those people pertaining to a trailer they moved in without permits.

Letter was read from Cecelia Dunchak of the Alloways Creek 4-H Club - They would like to hold their monthly meetings in township building meeting room. Supervisors discussed this and decided that if they permit one organization to hold meetings in the building it could lead to problems as everyone else in the township might want to hold their meetings in this building. Supervisors felt at this time it would be best to deny the request. A motion was made to deny this request by Neth, 2nd by Hilbert, carried. Secretary to write letter to Mrs. Dunchak explaining the decision.

Letter read from Schucharts about charges. Snyder went to see them about township getting charged for late payment. Schuchart understands that township can not possibly pay before their due date so they will waive finance charge.

Letter read from Littlestown Rec Board stating that they will again be offering recreation for residents of Littlestown and surrounding townships this summer.

Revenue Sharing cutting costs and will not be sending quarterly letters.

Glenn Snyder is to call Joyce of Miller Industries to see about acquiring a pull-type traction-driven sweeper.

Planning Commission had two (2) vacancies to be filled. One has been filled by Robert Miller. This being the remaining term of Glenn Black. Motion made by Snyder to appoint Mr. Miller to this remaining term, 2nd by Neth, carried. Jim Reaver wishes not to be re-appointed and his term should begin immediately. No volunteers and no apparent candidates at this time. Supervisors to think about who to ask to fill this vacancy.

Motion made to adjourn meeting at 8:30 p.m. by Neth, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.
