The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday February 16, 1989 at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried. Snyder moved to pay the township auditors, 2nd by Danner, carried.

A single lot sub-division of Donald, Daniel and Joyce Kraus was approved as presented by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

A four-lot sub-division of Hazel Crouse was approved by Snyder, 2nd by Danner, as presented.

Eileen Cool's sub-division of a portion of the open lot that she owns is to be added to the adjoining lot which she also owns, was approved by Harry Hilbert, 2nd by Danner, carried.

The sub-division plan of Wayne Lookenbill to transfer 4,000 sq. ft. from one lot to the next adjoining lot in Hillside Estates was approved by Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Moses Stoltzfus plan was not approved because lot #4 does not have access to a public road.

The supervisors reviewed the deed and the right of way of the roads in Hillside Estates and will instruct solicitor to record deed and agreement of right- of-way.

A letter was read from the Adams County Planning office instructing supervisors on new procedure to submit plans to the county office.

A letter from the county assessors office was read stating that due to the resignation of Bob Conover our new assessor is Betty Dobos.

Local Small Games of Chance Options - Resolution is as follows::

Be it resolved that the supervisors of Mt. Joy Township have the local small games of chance option placed on the May primary ballot. Snyder to contact solicitor to have the necessary papers prepared to have this on the May primary Ballot.*

The State Convention is to be held in Hershey starting April 24.

Supervisors gave tentative approval to Marty Miller for the three lots along route 15 and 97 (at corner), upon approval of satisfactory perculation tests on all three lots.

A letter was read from the Adams County Economic Strategy committee and the meeting will be held February 22, at 7:30 p.m.

Bridges - Crouse, Dague, and Basehoar-Roth Road need repairs done on tile. Snyder was instructed to get information on installing box culverts in these areas. Will contact our engineer, Dean Shultz, to help in the preparation for this project. Reviewed plans for the new bridge Penn Dot will be replacing on route 134 at Barlow. Also the detour which they have prepared.
