The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Jim Neth, carried. Letter was read from Department of Community Affairs concerning the Flood Plain Management Act 166. Snyder said we received letter and township is in violation of this act. He called the department and they will be sending information to us.

A letter was read concerning road turn-back from Penn-Dot. It concerned the date for the final application for turnback. The date is now November 1, 1984 in lieu of December 1 as in previous years.

Letter was received from Barlow fire chief stating the number of calls that were made in Mt. Joy Township in 1983 - 23.

Township received certificate of insurance verifying that SCATCOM has the proper amount of insurance.

A letter and application was received from DER to apply sewer sludge to the Hazel Crouse property. Sludge is to come from Penn Township and would be applied by them. Tabled any action until next meeting, going to check with our sewage enforcement officer and other townships to see if there is any problem with applying sewer sludge to farm land.

Received annual audit report from the Adams County Public Library.

Barry Gundlach was present concerning proposed Haven Acres, a revised sketch plan was presented, all lots now conform to size on his sketch plan. They may now continue with the steps necessary to conform with township subdivision ordinance.
