The assessors will not be elected, but will be appointed by the county. Mrs. Phillips is Mt. Joy Township's assessor and she seems to be doing her job quite well.

Electric Typewriter discussed. Secretary got price from Eicholtz. The price being \$563.00 for a new royal electric. A motion was made to purchase this typewriter by Waybright, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Neth, carried.

Lake Heritage Security - Don Wilkinson wanted commitment from supervisors that they would go along with the policing program that was discussed at the prior meeting. Supervisors told him that at the present time they have not had enough time to discuss this matter with anyone else or even among themselves. Supervisors will set up a meeting with other townships within the Lake Heritage area and discuss this matter.
