Letter read from 2330 Low Dutch Road - Patsy Harnett - storm drain almost completely filled with silt and dirt - Snyder checked it out and cleaned it.

Letter from Tom Collins, County Commissioner - would township go along with authority and recycling - township supervisors not in 100 % agreement with all contents of Adams County Solid Waste Management book. Snyder made motion to send letter to the Commissioners advising them that they will go along with the recommendation of recycling and the creation of a County Solid Waste Authority but they DO NOT concur with the incineration part at this particular time.

Mr. Mearns is worried that Long Road is being abandoned. Supervisors assured him that it is still township road.
